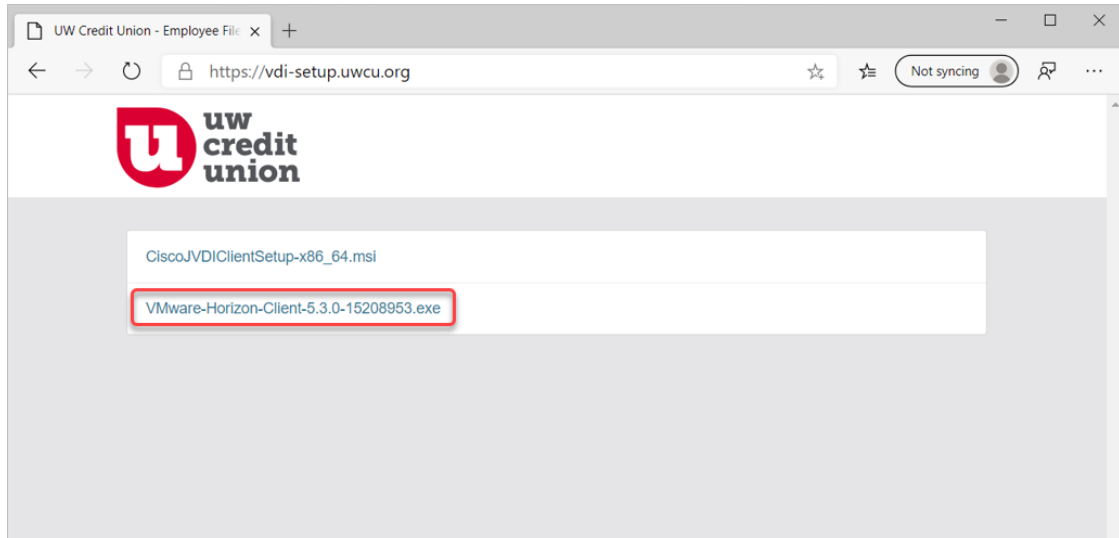
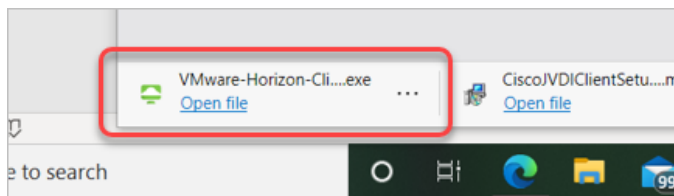


## Install the VMware Horizon Client application

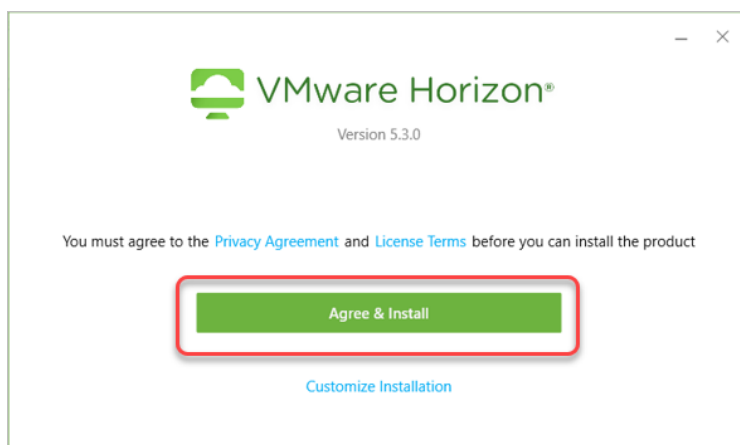
1. Open a browser (Chrome, IE, or Edge) and go to <https://vdi-setup.uwcu.org>
2. From the vdi-setup page, click on the link for **VMWare-Horizon-Client-5.3.0-15208953.exe** to download the application file.



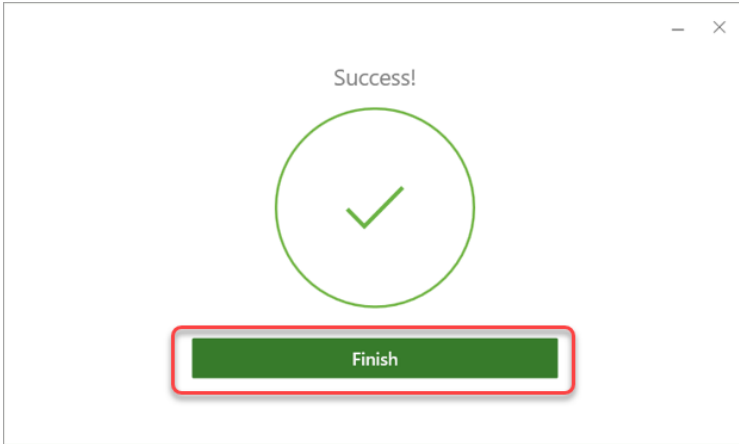
3. When the file has finished downloading, click **Open File** at the bottom of your browser window



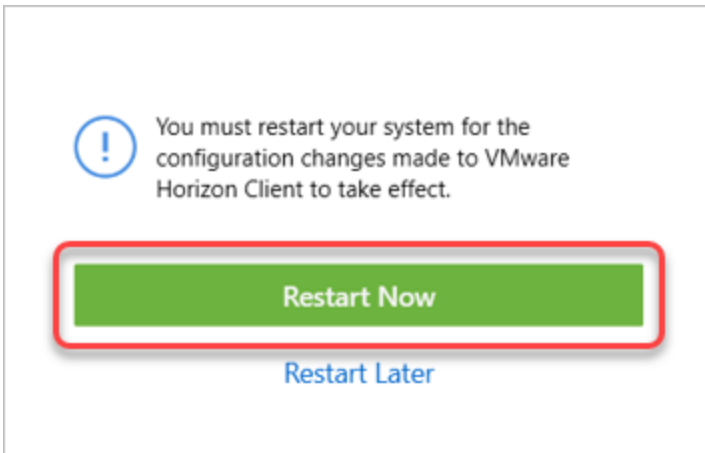
4. A popup window may appear asking to “Allow this program to make changes to your computer”, click the **Yes** button
5. Click on the **Agree & Install** button in the “VMware Horizon” popup window.



6. When the installation completes, click on the **Finish** button



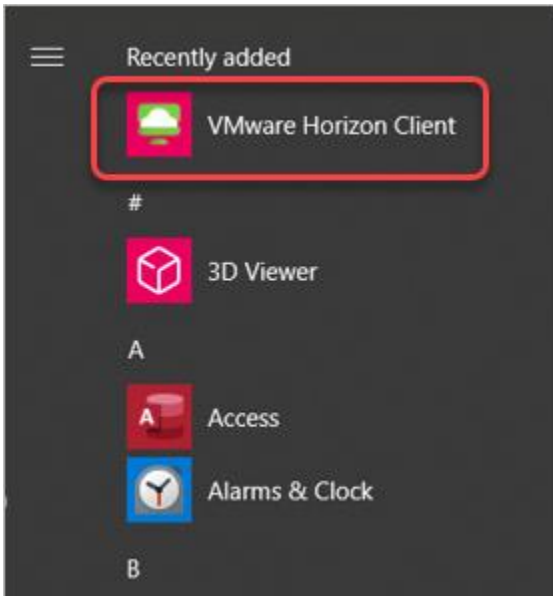
7. A popup window will appear, save any open work and click on the **Restart Now** button



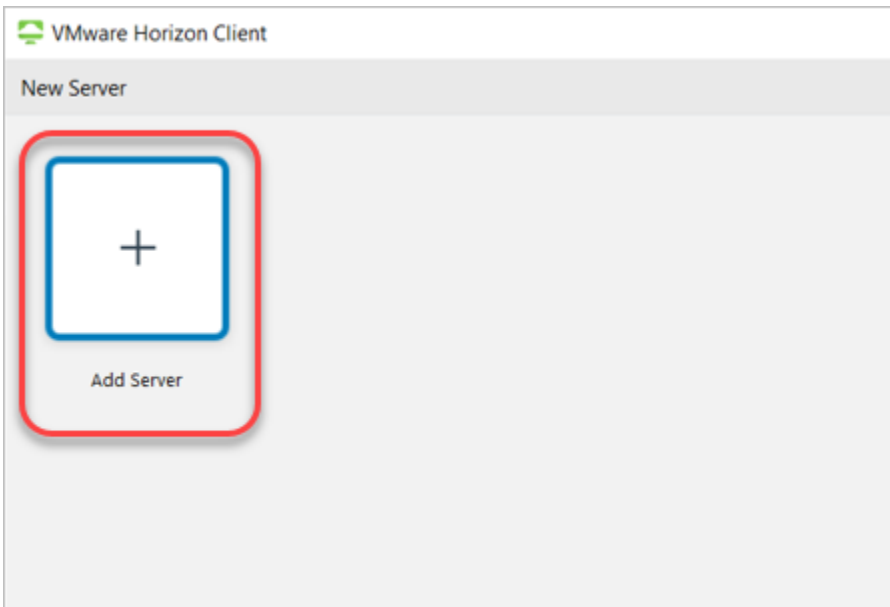

## Set up the VMware Horizon Client application

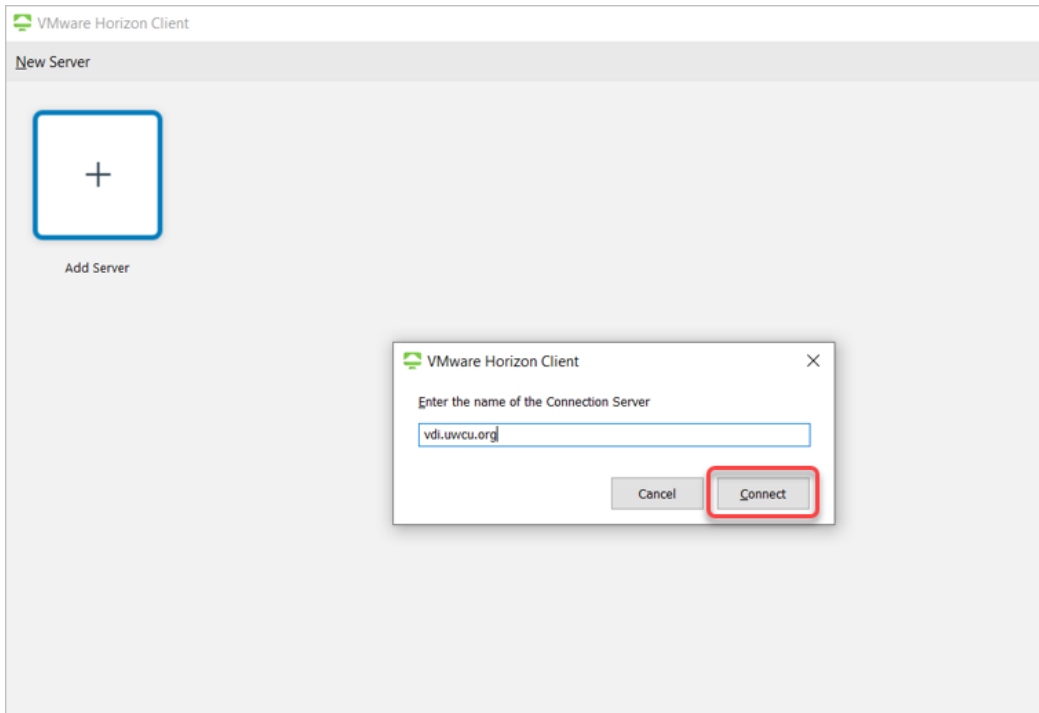
1. Click on the windows (start) button
2. Click the VMware Horizon Client application in the Start menu



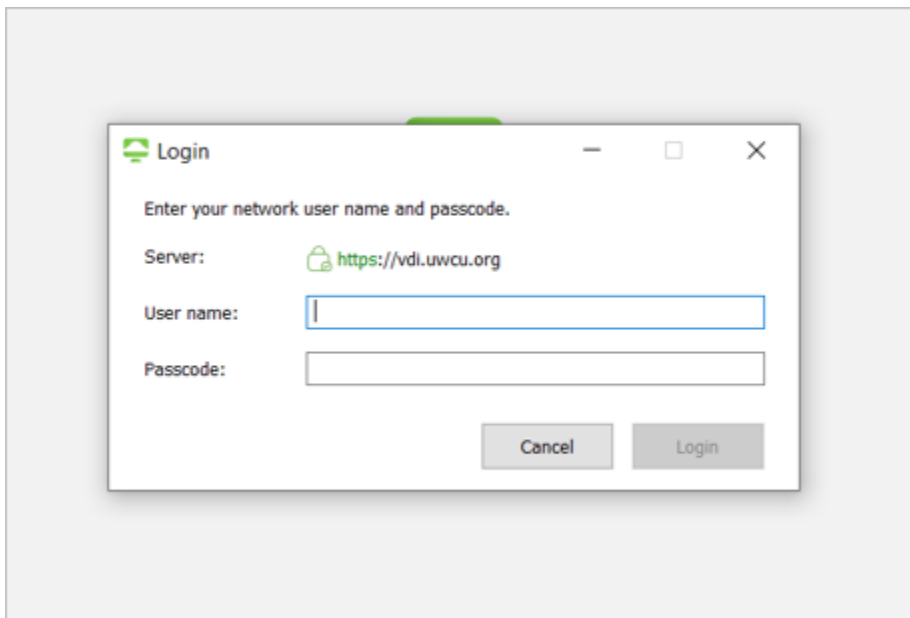
3. From the VMware Horizon Client window, double-click on the **+ Add Server** button



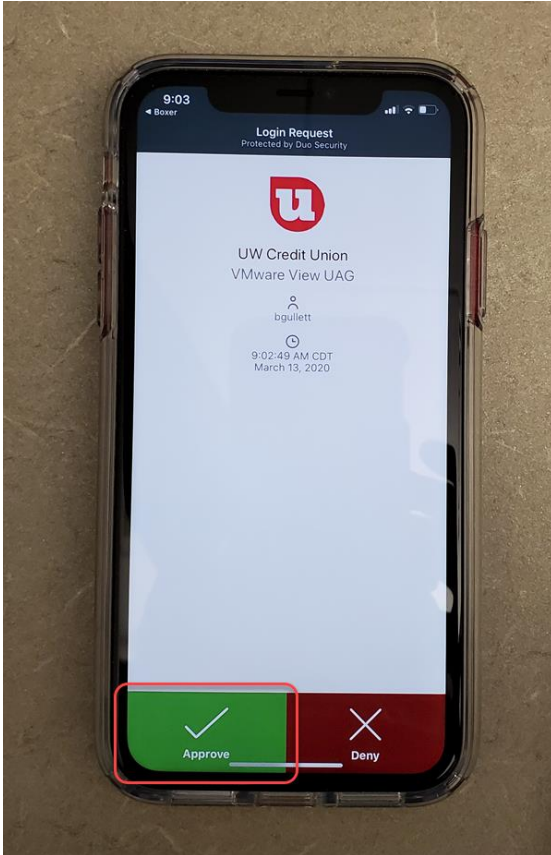
4. In the popup window, enter **vdi.uwcu.org** and click on the **Connect** button



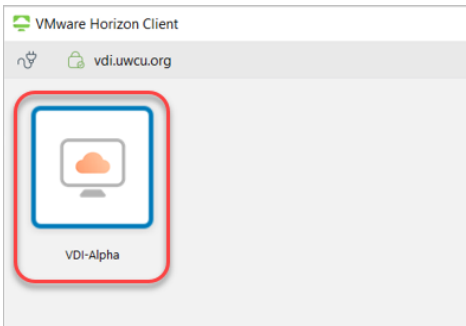
5. In the “Login” popup window, enter the username and password you use to login to your work computer and click on the **Login** button



6. A Duo (two factor authentication) prompt will appear
7. Enter 1 to receive a popup on your work provide mobile device. Tap the “Approve” button on the Duo Mobile app



8. From the VMware Horizon Client window, double-click the VDI connection listed on the VMware Horizon Client window
